REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND OFFICERS

Executive Committee (John Alexander)

- President Alexander provided clarification on the Right-of-Way at West Beechwold Blvd and Riverview Park.
 This area is private property and any plantings require the consent of the owner and approval by the City
 Forester
- President Alexander contacted Leslie Westerfelt from the City of Columbus regarding the city's plans to address
 overflows as a part of Blueprint Columbus. Our neighborhood is being surveyed and a preliminary plan
 developed. Leslie anticipates neighbors will be invited to a meeting in October to offer input and feedback on
 the initial plan for Old Beechwold.
- HISTORIC DISTRICT ACTIONS: April & May: none; June: 63 W Beechwold Blvd; tree removal; 71 W Jeffrey Place; gutters; July: 4914 Olentangy Blvd; window repair & painting.

Treasurer's report (Laura Philip):

- The Association had an ending balance of \$18,981.29 as of July 23, 2018. (See the attached report for details). Sixty homeowners have paid dues.
- A survey regarding a membership directory was distributed with the dues statements. The majority were in favor of an electronic directory that had options to limit the specific information included.
- Bids were solicited for snow and leaf removal. GAG will continue as the vendor. This year homeowners will
 have the option of selecting either the end of October or the last week of November for leaf pick-up with
 late November as the default date.

Secretary's report (Dianne Radigan)

 A committee is being formed to provide insight and advice on the Old Beechwold Association's website and other forms of communication. The intent is to make the site more valuable and utilized by homeowners and facilitate communication.

Arbor Committee (Lindalee Brownstein)

- Thank you to all working hard to clean up invasive plants, water, mulch, fertilize and prune bushes in the neighborhood.
